Abstract

This document illustrates the format for papers to be submitted to the EEUG September 2005 Workshop. This template should be used to prepare the paper. A4 paper should be used, with 2.5cm margins for Top, Bottom, Left and Right. Do not number the pages. The paper should be submitted electronically via email, in Word, Postscript or PDF formats, to Ian.Grout@ul.ie. The paper length should not exceed 6 pages.

1 Title

The title of the paper should be in capital letters and centred, using 14point **bold** Times New Roman font. The paper is to be fully justified, except where instructed to centre text or images/tables.

2 Abstract

An abstract of a maximum of 100 words should be placed immediately below the title section, using italic 11point Times New Roman font. The abstract should be fully justified, except for the Heading, which is to be centred.

3 Headings

Headings should be numbered as shown, using 11point **bold** Times New Roman font.

3.1 Second level headings

Second level section headings should be 11point **bold** Times New Roman font and numbered as shown.

4 Normal text

The main text of the paper should use 11point Times New Roman with single line spacing. An 11point space should be inserted after each paragraph. The paper should be presented in single column format.

Images and tables should be centred and provided with a numbered caption. Use only monochrome images where possible. Caption text should be below the image or table in Times New Roman 11point, followed by an 11point space.
